STUDENT RECOMMENDATION PROCESS

Referrals to Project Y.E.S. are made by school personnel to the Project Y.E.S. Coordinator or Pupil Services Team on the Student Recommendation form. The team will gather vital information to determine if the student would benefit from Project Y.E.S. services. If the student qualifies, the Project Y.E.S. Coordinator will contact both student and parent to further discuss the program expectations. A plan will be developed for each individual student. All parties involved will work together to ensure a successful outcome.
